

External Dose in Excess of ALARA guidelines

Reported Dose from Laboratory

All exposures exceeding the administrative and/or NRC ALARA guidelines shall be reported to the Radiation Safety Officer as appropriate.

RSO Investigations of Overexposures

The Radiation Safety Office shall investigate all exposures exceeding the administrative and/or NRC ALARA guidelines. The RSO is responsible for notification to the appropriate agencies in cases of known or suspected exposures that exceed the permitted limits. Whenever these exposure limits have been reached or exceeded, depending upon the extent of the overexposure, personnel may be required to avoid future work with radiation for a period of time.

Correction of Reported Dose

If after evaluation of the reported dose, the RSO determines that the exposure was inaccurate or incorrect for the individuals permanent dose record, the following may be submitted to correct the record:

- A letter from the RSO shall be submitted to correct the dose of record.
- 2. The corrected dose shall be proposed for:
 - a. User Name
 - b. Date of Exposure
 - c. Dosimetry ID
